



VCheck24 for Juvenile Supervision

In some cases, an ankle monitor may inadvertently create stigmatizing situations or adverse treatment of juveniles being monitored, leading to inequities, negative self-image, and depression among the juvenile population. A combination of VCheck24's zone-triggering check-ins (school and home) and scheduled check-ins may facilitate a smoother transition for certain juveniles.

VCheck24 is also effective as a graduated sanction in between GPS ankle bracelet monitoring and no electronic monitoring...an incentive to do well on the ankle bracelet and graduate past it, but not a full removal of EM. Regular video check-ins allow the supervising agent to see and hear the client's voice as well as check the surrounding environment for any concerning images and sounds. Current features include:
